Report on First Parish Annual Meeting

The 73rd Annual Meeting for First Parish was held in late March. At this meeting, the 2022 Annual Budget of \$286,000 was approved. Pledges made for 2022 total \$142,825, which represent an increase over the prior year. Other important revenue projections for the year include revenue to be generated by the Annual Yard Sale and Christmas Fair, revenue from the cell tower located in the church steeple, rental fees for use of the church facilities, investment income and miscellaneous other sources.

An additional presentation made at the Annual Meeting covered the upcoming capital program and associated capital campaign to raise necessary funds. Identified capital projects include restoration of the barn,

steeple upgrades, sanctuary ceiling renovation and carpet replacement, and replacement of steps leading to front of church (facing Nahatan Street). Opportunities will be coming up for all to learn more about these projects.
